COUNCIL PROGRAMS

Union Cities

The Metropolitan Washington Council, AFL-CIO is proud to be an award-winning Union City. The AFL-CIO Union Cities initiative unites international unions, state federations, central labor councils and local unions in a common effort to educate and motivate union members, defend the right of workers to join unions, organize thousands of new members and create a powerful new voice that speaks for working families.

The Council's Union City program coordinates the Street Heat mobilization network of over 30,000 local activists -- one of the biggest in the nation -- who keep up and regularly turn out for solidarity actions, alerted through *Union City*, the award-winning daily email newsletter distributed to activists, allies, media and political leaders (sign up via website, phone, fax or email below.) Union Cities provides strategic and logistical support to Council affiliates organizing workers, negotiating contracts or mobilizing during strikes and other workplace actions.

The Union City program also coordinates the annual DC Labor FilmFest (see Page 10) and works with allies in the religious community on the Labor in the Pulpits/On the Bimah/Minbar program and other issues critical to local workers and the community.

The Union City program works year-round to reintegrate the labor movement into our local community, building long-term, mutually beneficial relationships with community, religious, student and senior allies who share our commitment to helping working people improve their lives.

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COUNCIL PROGRAMS

Committee on Political Education (COPE)

The Metropolitan Labor Council coordinates lobbying and legislative activities at the DC City Council, the Montgomery County Council, the Prince George's County Council, and the County Commissions in Charles, Calvert and St. Mary's Counties. The Labor Council also works directly with the Maryland State & DC AFL-CIO during the Maryland General Assembly, promoting labor interests through legislative activities such as lobbying and member mobilization and political activities including screening and endorsements of candidates, get-out-the-vote activities, and mobilization of members for grassroots actions.

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Community Services Agency

The Community Services Agency (CSA) of the Metropolitan Washington Council, AFL-CIO, is the only labor-sponsored charitable organization in the metro area.

While providing most services to anyone needing help, the CSA's special emphasis is on unions and their members in Northern Virginia, suburban Maryland and Washington, D.C.

The CSA not only assists workers in their time of need, but also works to harness and share the generosity of the local labor movement as we work to make our communities better places to live.

CSA's services include information and referral services, including financial, housing, family and legal problems, limited emergency financial assistance, lay-off preparation workshops, Holiday Basket Project, Union Community Activist Network Training, Building Futures Apprenticeship Outreach and Recruitment Project. 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COUNCIL PROGRAMS

Claimant Advocacy Program

The Claimant Advocacy Program (CAP) is a free legal counseling service available to individuals who file unemployment compensation appeals in the District of Columbia. CAP attorneys meet with workers denied unemployment compensation in D.C. or whose benefit awards have been appealed by the employer. If the case is accepted, the CAP attorney appears at the hearing as the worker's legal representative.

Representation is made on a case-by-case basis based on the facts of each appeals claim. However, all claimants can receive free legal counseling.

COUNCIL PROGRAMS

DC Labor FilmFest

Since 2001 the DC Labor FilmFest has screened hundreds of films about work and workers, bringing directors, stars, workers and activists together in an annual celebration of the struggle for economic and social justice.

Sponsored by the Metro Washington Council, AFL-CIO, the Debs-Jones-Douglass Institute and the American Film Institute, the Labor FilmFest is one of the only film festivals in the world dedicated to screening films featuring workers and workers' issues.

The DC Labor FilmFest continues to grow in popularity, drawing thousands of attendees each October, and is one of the most-anticipated events on the local labor calendar. The FilmFest specializes in bringing new labor-related films to local audiences, as well as presenting high-quality prints of classic labor films.

Highlights of the DC Labor FilmFest's first decade include the DC premiere of *Fair Game* with Valerie Plame and Joe Wilson, Michael Moore hosting the DC premiere of *Capitalism: A Love Story*, the North American premiere of Ken Loach's *It's A Free World*, the DC premiere of Costa Gavras' *The Ax*, Jane Fonda hosting a 25th anniversary screening of *9 to 5*, a special screening of *Harlan County, USA* with director Barbara Kopple, the restored print of Gillo Pontecorvo's *Burn!*, Stephen Frears' *Dirty Pretty Things* and many more.

Since 2011 the DC Labor FilmFest has also organized and hosted the International Labor Film Festival Organizer's Conference, which brings together labor film festival organizers from around the world to explore ways to build the global labor film festival movement.

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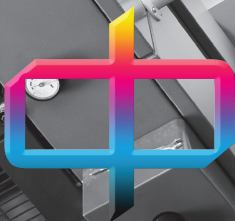
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
