Craig Simpson reviewed the actions & recommendations made by the Executive Board.

It was moved & seconded to approve the DC recommendations. Moved to amend the motion to separate DC Council Chair recommendation from the main motion. Jerry Lozupone (WBCTC) argued that there was almost 2/3 support for Kathy Patterson in the Executive Board vote and he'd like delegates to have a chance to vote on Patterson. The motion failed 25-18; the original motion was approved overwhelmingly.

Jim Lowery (IUEC 10) pointed out that in St Mary's, there were only 4 candidates for the Democratic Central Committee until labor jumped in, now there are 12 candidates, so this proved labor can have an impact.

Craig Simpson and Rick Powell reported on plans for labor's field campaign, emphasizing that victory depends on turning out as many volunteers and voters as possible.

Fred Allen reported on DC Ward 5 activities.
