## **COPE**

Powell then reviewed the Prince George's County COPE recommendations. Extensive discussion and debate followed, after which it was moved, seconded and approved to recommend to the delegates that actions in the Prince George's races be tabled until a special meeting in July, and to request authorization to take action at that point.

Alya Solomon, Assistant Political Coordinator, reviewed the recommendations of the DC COPE. Extensive discussion and debate followed. Vance Ayres (WBCTC) moved the Council take "No Position" in the DC City Council Chair race, but the motion died when it failed to receive a second. Earl O'Neill (AFSCME Council 20) moved that the Council endorse Kwame Brown for Chair, seconded by Mark McLaurin (SEIU 500). The vote was 9 yes, 3 no and 3 abstentions, and the motion

failed for lack of a two-thirds majority. Anthony Garland (ATU 689) then moved that the Council take "No Position" in the DC City Council Chair race, seconded by Murphy (IUOE 99); the vote was 5-5 and failed for lack of a two-thirds majority. After further discussion, it was moved, seconded and unanimously approved to report to the delegates that the Board is not prepared to make a recommendation at this time and request authorization to act at the July Executive Board meeting. It was moved, seconded and approved to recommend "No Position" in Ward 1, endorse Mary Cheh in Ward 3 and to postpone action in Ward 6 and request delegate authorization to act at the July Executive Board meeting.

John Boardman, Unite Here Local 25, made a proposal to host a labor fundraiser for Vince Gray on July 7 at the Unite Here 25 offices; the proposal was accepted by the Board.

President Williams advised the Board of a recommendation that's in the works for an independent expenditure campaign in the DC Mayor's race, that would have a budget of \$400,000. Rick Powell distributed the draft proposal, but President Williams noted that it will require more time to review before formally discussing and taking action.
